How will this project improve accessibility?

This project will solve multiple accessibility challenges:

- The west entrance will be graded to accommodate ease of entry. The three steps and lift inside the west entrance will be eliminated.
- 16 parking spaces will be added on the west side of the church, 4 designated handicapped.
- Finally, an elevator will be installed to afford everyone the dignity of safe and secure transportation between the sanctuary level and the lower level of the building which houses Fellowship Hall, Sunday School classrooms, and Polo Community Preschool.

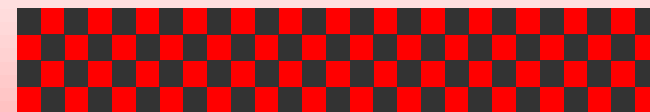
